- "as happy as a clam" comparing someone's happiness to the contentment of a clam
- "Life is like a box of chocolates, you never know what you're going to get."

3. The funeral raced by me in a blur.
4. While making my way to my car, it appeared to smile at me mischievously.

Personification

Metaphors

- The world is a stage.
- My kid's room is a disaster area.
- The computers at school are old dinosaurs
- Kisses are the flowers of affection. (1)
- His words were cotton candy.

Onomatopoeia

Chug, chug, chug. Puff, puff, puff. Ding-dong, ding-dong. The little train rumbled over the track. I knew we had finally left the city when I could hear the gentle moo of the cows in the field.
